



Terms and Conditions for Centre for Human Specific Research Events

These terms and conditions apply between the person, company or other entity specified on your booking form ("you" or "your") and **Animal Free Research UK** ("we" or "our"), a company limited by guarantee incorporated in England and Wales (company number 08015625) and registered with the Charity Commission (charity number 1146896) whose registered office is at 27 Old Gloucester Street, London, England, WC1N 3AX, for attendee registration for the event specified on your booking form ("Event").

The **Centre for Human Specific Research** is an initiative of Animal Free Research UK, and Events organised under the Centre are delivered and administered by Animal Free Research UK.

By submitting your registration to attend the Event ("your registration") you agree to be bound by these terms. If your registration is submitted by a proxy, these terms will still apply to you.

This Event is organised by Animal Free Research UK, which reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to limit or deny access to any person or entity. To be eligible to attend, you must be 18 years old or older, unless by prior agreement.

Registration

You will receive an automated confirmation of your registration to the email address provided in the booking form. If you have not received that confirmation within five working days of your registration, please email us at enquiries@humanspecificresearch.org.

We require that all fees are paid in full on registering. We reserve the right to refuse entry to the venue in the circumstance that payment has not been made. Prices for each Event, where applicable, are correct at the time of publication. We reserve the right to change the prices at any time but changes will not affect registrations which have already been confirmed by us.

We are not registered for VAT.

We may offer discounted registrations with deadlines by which the discount expires, and we reserve the right to change the dates of these deadlines at our discretion. Discounts can only be applied at the time of registration and cannot be combined. If you register for an Event under a discounted arrangement, you may be asked to provide evidence of your eligibility or be liable to pay the full fee.

Refunds are not available except in extenuating circumstances or in the event of cancellation by us. We reserve the right to cancel the Event at our discretion. Notification of any significant amendment will be communicated to all attendees as soon as possible via email.

In the event of cancellation, a full refund will be provided where applicable. If the Event is rescheduled, attendees may choose to have their registration cancelled and refunded where applicable or transferred to the new location / date. Options and details will be circulated via email at the time of cancellation.

Please note, in the event of cancellation or postponement, we will not be responsible for any costs you have incurred for travel, accommodation or any other related service.

Requests to transfer your registration to an alternative person may be made at any time in the lead up to the Event start date but must be approved by us and will be at our discretion. Email enquiries@humanspecificresearch.org with the details of your transfer. A £20 administration fee will be applicable to all such transfers.

In all other respects your registration is issued for the personal use of you only and cannot be shared with any other person. By registering you agree that your registration will not be resold and any attempts to do so will result in your registration being cancelled without prior notification.

The Event

You may be asked to provide ID and proof of registration upon arrival at the venue. You will receive a name badge at registration and must be in possession of it at all times. Any person identified as not being in possession of a name badge during the Event will be asked to immediately show proof of registration or may be asked to leave.

We reserve the right to alter details of the Event such as date and time, location and the programme after publication. Any alterations will be communicated to you via email as soon as possible.

You agree that we reserve the right to remove you from the Event if we, in our sole discretion, determine that your participation or behaviour creates a nuisance or hinders the enjoyment of other participants. Please maintain a respectful, considerate and courteous attitude towards everyone you engage with at the Event.

Unauthorised photography and the recording or transmitting of audio or visual material is expressly prohibited. However, you are encouraged to capture your Event experience in permitted areas of the venue and post your own social media content, provided that it does not defame other participants or infringe on copyrighted content.

You may be photographed or filmed at times and the recordings and photographs may be distributed by us for marketing and publicity purposes. If you do not wish to be included in close-up photography or video recording, please inform a member of the Event organising team on the day and we will do our best to accommodate your request.

General Terms

We reserve the right to amend these terms from time to time. However, you will be subject to the terms and conditions in force at the time you submit your registration.

Your privacy will always be respected in our communications between you and ourselves. We shall use your personal data for the purpose of providing services in relation to this Event, such as registration, communications, venue admission, payment, feedback and research.

Where an event has sponsors, and for the purposes of facilitating professional networking and transparency at the Event, we may share a delegate list with Event sponsors. This delegate list will be limited to the attendee's name, job title and organisation.

We will not share attendees' email addresses or other contact details with sponsors unless we have obtained the attendee's explicit consent to do so. Sponsors are required to use this information solely in connection with the Event and in accordance with applicable data protection legislation.

the extent and within the jurisdiction in which that term is illegal, invalid or unenforceable, it shall be severed and deleted from these terms and the remaining terms shall survive and continue to be binding and enforceable.

These terms shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales, and any disputes shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
